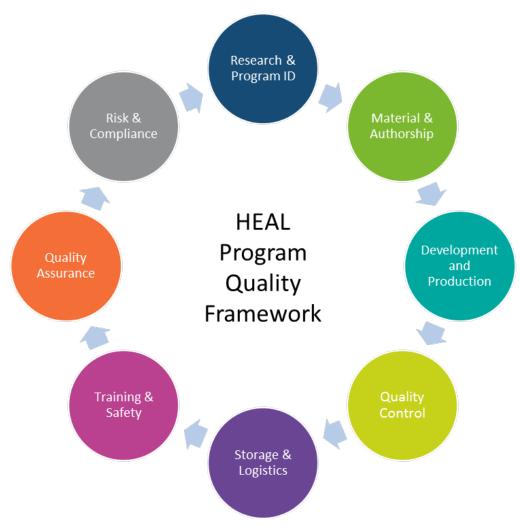
## **HEAL Program Quality Framework**

The HEAL Program Quality Framework is underpinned by the best evidence models used in the development and evaluation of education and training. These include:

- The Analysis, Design, Development, Implementation and Evaluation (ADDIE) instructional design systems framework <sup>1</sup>
- Kirkpatrick evaluation model <sup>2</sup> and the
- Plan, Do, Study, Act (PDSA) cycle. 3
